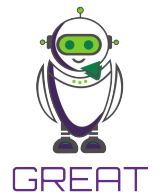

SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES

1. Watch the following video and say what human rights are infringed.
2. Prepare an audio podcast on democracy in book.....- individually
3. In groups of 5-7 make a short video starting from the book (students'choice from a list studied in class) :
 - include English subtitles
 - submit the script – original one
4. Make a trailer for the film.....based on the book
5. Read the book.....and in your group prepare a presentation that will obligatorily include the following:
 - A Power Point/ Prezi presentation (10 slides) – reading factsheets
 - a speech (5 minutes) to convince the audience to read the book
 - a cover for the book /a poster to promote the book
 - 2 excerpts from the book read loud, highlighted and commented upon
 - a trailer/ a comic book based on the book
